Travis Don Powers, passed away on August 26th, 2025, at the age of 59.

Born in Perth Amboy, NJ, on June 1st 1966, he spent most of his life in Old Bridge NJ, where he was known for his diesel mechanic skills, and his unyielding love of the Las Vegas Raiders and the NJ Devils. Whether it was a game day or casual conversation about the latest scores, he brought an energy and enthusiasm that will be sorely missed.

Travis began his career in 1984 at Mini Max Trucking in Edison, NJ, before moving on to be head mechanic of various trucking companies for the next decade. He was a loving son, survived by his mother, Errell Krug. Travis is also survived by his two grandchildren, Owen and Kendyl Ernst. Travis is predeceased by his father, Paul Powers, and loving brother, Shane Powers. We take comfort in imagining their reunion now.

Travis spent his final days in Tuckerton, NJ surrounded by his cherished family, while cancer unfortunately pulled him away. The family would like to acknowledge all those who have been a part of Travis' life in all the ways a person can be.
